Bred By Exhibitor Class Eligibility: All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a Breeder of Record of the dog and an Owner of Record of the dog. To exhibit in this class family members must be a Breeder and Owner of Record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES
❖ Veteran Class – For dogs or bitches 7 years or older. The winners of this class may compete for Best of Breed, but it is not required. ❖ Field Trial Class – Open to German Shorthair Pointer Dogs or Bitches that have placed or received a Judge's Award of Merit in an American Kennel Club or Member Club Field Trial ❖ Hunting Test Titled Class – Open to German Shorthair Pointer Dogs or Bitches that have completed a JH, SH, or MH Title from the American Kennel Club Hunting Tests.
<i>At an Independent Specialty when there is no competition beyond Best of Breed, a dog or bitch that has been spayed or neutered may compete in these non-regular classes. By virtue of winning this class, may compete for Best of Breed, if otherwise undefeated at this specialty.</i>
NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES
Non-Regular classes involving multiple dog entries will be judged after Best of Breed
❖ Stud Dog Class – Stud Dog plus no less than two and no more than three get ❖ Brood Bitch Class – Brood Bitch plus no less than two and no more than three get
Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy, or breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited must wear arm bands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog class and a spay bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION AWARD OF MERIT GRAND CHAMPION - SELECT
Grand Champion points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. All dogs chosen for the Select Award must be Champions of Record in order to be awarded Grand Champion points.

Entry shown in sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. On the same entry form indicate in the space for "Additional Classes" your entry in the sweepstakes, including the age division. Entry fee is \$15.00

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES: This sweepstakes is open to all GSPs 7 years or older on the day of the show. Dogs entered in the veteran sweepstakes DO NOT NEED to be entered in the regular classes. Spayed and neutered animals may complete. On the same entry form indicate in the space for "Additional Classes" your entry in the sweepstakes, including the age division. Entry fee is \$15.00

All Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular classes.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Age division counted on the day of the event:

Junior 9 and under 12 years; Intermediate 12 and under 15 years; Senior 15 & under 18 years

Achievement level: Novice, Open, Master

When filling out entry forms: achievement level and age division Example: **Novice Junior**

Novice. This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master. This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Reserve Best Junior Handler An All Breed club offering Junior Showmanship shall offer Reserve Best Junior Handler, a Group Club or Specialty Club has the option to offer Reserve Best Junior. After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

Each dog entered in a regular Junior showmanship Class at an all-breed dog show must be an AKC recognized breed or FSS Breed with an AKC number and at least 6 months of age on the day of the event. A Limited Breed Dog Club, Group Show, has the 4 option to offer the opportunity for a Junior to show any breed eligible to be entered at an All breed event or a breed eligible to compete in that event including the Miscellaneous Class breeds. At Specialty Shows, only the breed for the specialty is eligible to be entered. Dogs may be PAL, Full-, or Limited-Registered to compete in Junior Showmanship Classes, additionally, spayed and neutered specimens are eligible for competition. A Foreign dog, from a registry accepted by AKC for Registration, of an AKC Recognized breed is eligible to be entered on it's foreign number in accordance with Rules Applying to Dog Shows Chapter 11, Section 1. The dog must be entered in one of the classes associated with the event or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. An eligible dog other than the one entered may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. The junior must have the AKC number of the substitute dog. All such substitutions must be made with the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A Junior is limited to one substitution at a dog show. If one of the owners of the dog is a judge, the dog may be entered in Junior Showmanship Only to be exhibited by the Junior at an event where the judge is judging classes other than Junior Showmanship. Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank.

ENTRIES open Wednesday, August 5, 2026 at 8 am (PST). Due to limited entries, they must be mailed to the secretary's address. No entry will be accepted before the opening date and time. No entries will be accepted by phone, fax, or email. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: 12:00 PM (NOON) Wednesday, September 09, 2026 OR when the maximum entry has been reached, after which no entries may be accepted, canceled or changed. In the event that maximum entry is reached, a waiting list will be maintained.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

TELEPHONE, FAXED, UNSIGNED or INCOMPLETE ENTRIES cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms & photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

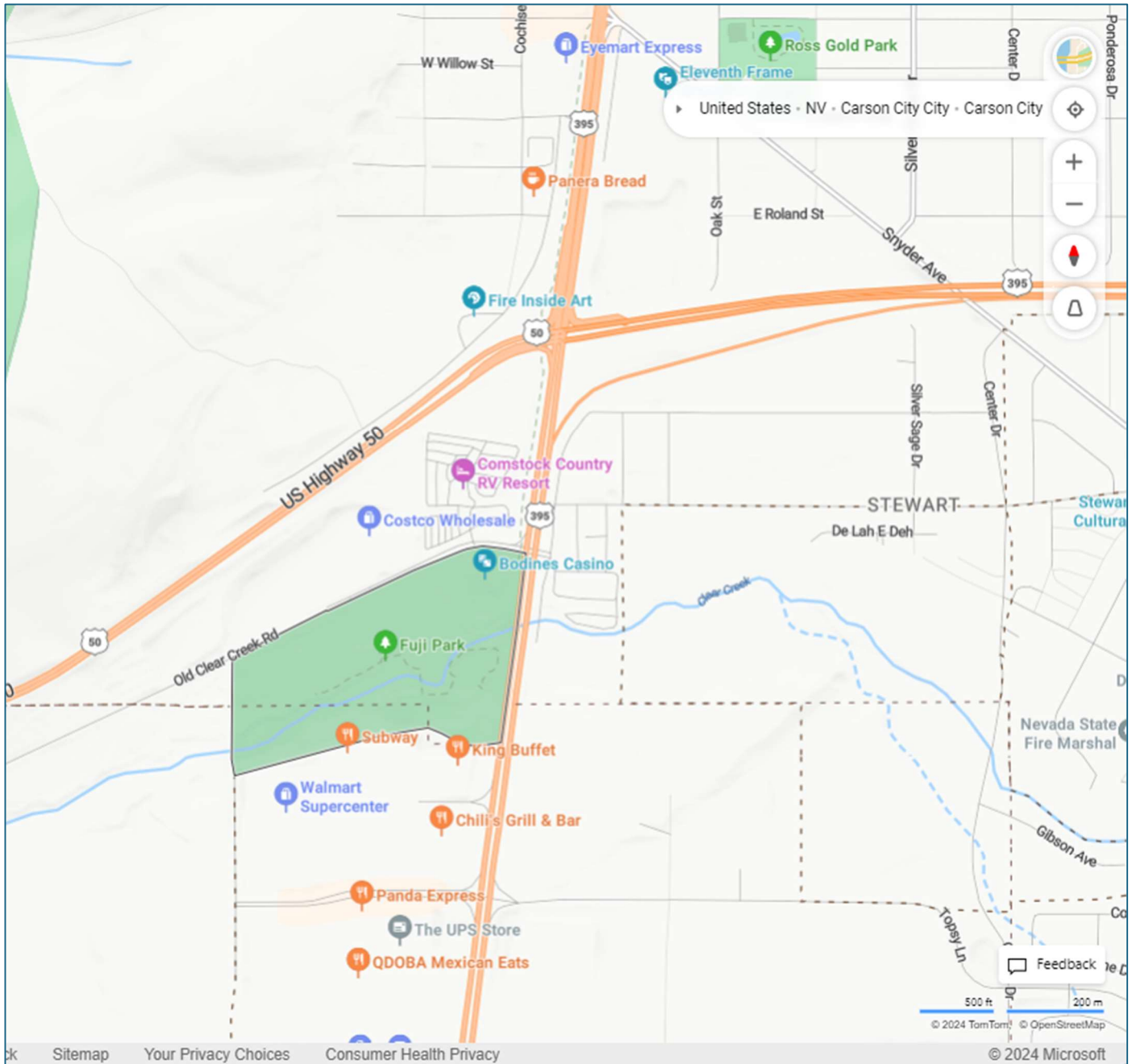

How To Use The Entry Blank: Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the same for each day. Carefully check the box for each show in which you wish to enter your dog. A separate form should be used if the same dog is entered in different classes on different days. The boxes indicating the shows you wish to enter must be checked. Please TYPE or PRINT all information on entry forms.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, venue contract cancellation or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

Transfers/Move-ups will be permitted. Please notify the Trial Secretary in writing as soon as possible, **but at least 30 minutes prior to start of that day's judging. (before 8AM)**
